Department of Science and Technology-DOST

Filipino applicants are advised to check with the respective national Contact Point the eligibility as to who may apply and what costs are eligible before a consortium submits the complete application. Furthermore, it is recommended to Filipino applicants to read the Philippine call text on the DOST website (www.dost.gov.ph).

Eligibility

Research proposals may be submitted by Filipinos (based in the Philippines):

- Research institutions
- Universities (public and private)
- SMEs

Funding modalities

For researchers funded by the Department of Science and Technology, the funding is limited to:

1. Applied Research
2. Experimental Development
3. Pilot Testing
4. Technology Transfer

The grant shall finance project expenditures itemized in a Line-item budget (DOST Form No. 2B-2). It may cover partial or full cost of the project, both direct and indirect costs of personal services, maintenance and other operating expenses, and equipment. Procurement of goods shall be subject to the usual public bidding consistent with existing government accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations. The Funding Agency shall own all equipment purchased through grant funds until such are transferred to the implementing institution or other projects.

All partner countries cover the costs for their participants based on respective national regulations.

Personnel costs:

May include salaries and wages, honoraria, fees and other compensation of consultants and specialists hired for a project. Payment of salaries and honoraria shall be based on the DOST prescribed rates and other existing applicable or relevant guidelines, circulars or order of competent authority pursuant to law and implementing rules and regulations.

Indirect costs: Overheads

The total indirect cost of a program/project shall not exceed 15% (shared by the implementing and monitoring agencies) of the total cost of personnel services and miscellaneous and other operating expenses.

Submission

Beyond the submission of the proposal through the dedicated online tool (PT-OUTLINE) the Filipino applicants shall be required to submit a **signed version of the PT-OUTLINE generated PDF including the institution's stamp** via post to the Filipino National Contact Point.
