The Research Project grant is open to individual researchers. The researcher will be the project leader and scientific supervisor of the project.

Eligibility

Eligibility of the proposal

To be able to apply, the researcher's organization needs to be an approved administrating organization. Should this not be the case, please see the Swedish Research Council's [requirements for administrating organisations](#).

Eligibility of applying scientists

- The applicant must hold a Swedish doctoral degree or an equivalent foreign degree awarded no later than the deadline of this call. The date of issue will be considered to be the point in time when all the requirements of the degree were fulfilled for example mandatory courses, the oral public defense of the doctoral thesis and the approved doctoral thesis.
- Active participation in the project must equal at least 20 percent of a full-time equivalent.
- If the researcher is awarded funding, he or she must be employed by the administrating organization when the grant period begins unless the Swedish Research Council, the administrating organization or another employer (where applicable) agree otherwise. The employment must equal at least 20 per cent of a full-time equivalent. The researcher does not have to be employed by the administrating organization when the application is submitted.

Funding modalities

The Swedish Research Council funds projects in the thematic areas of Health (Anti-microbial drug resistance, Emerging infectious diseases). The Swedish Research Council has committed SEK 15 million in total over 3 years to the call. The maximum funding for a Swedish project partner is SEK 3 million in total. If a project consists of more than one Swedish partner, the total maximum funding of all Swedish partners in the project is SEK 3 million. The requested amount shall also include indirect costs.

The grant will be administered by a Swedish HEI, or another public organization in Sweden that fulfils the Swedish Research Council's [requirements for administrating organisations](#).
