Swiss applicants are advised to check with the respective National Contact Points the eligibility as to who may apply and what costs are eligible before a consortium submits the complete application.

**Eligibility of applying scientists**

Applicants requesting funding must meet the eligibility requirements of the SNSF. The [SNSF Funding Regulations](#), the [General implementation regulations](#) and the [Regulations on Project Funding](#) are applicable or applicable mutatis mutandis.

Please note that partners of an international project consortium located in a country of the Joint Funding Scheme consortium cannot be declared as project partners in the sense of article 11.2 of the SNSF [Funding Regulations](#). They should be declared as consortium partner instead and apply for their funding at their respective research funding organisation.

**Funding modalities**

The maximum amount allocated per project is CHF 250,000.-

Grants will be managed according to standard SNSF rules; reporting requirements duplicating those of the JFS will not be enforced.

**Submission**

Applicants must provide basic administrative data by submitting administrative applications via the online submission system [mySNF](#) for the same deadlines as the consortium applications are submitted. Please select the "Programmes/Southeast Asia – Europe Joint Funding Scheme" funding instrument.
