National Science Technology Development Agency (NSTDA)

Thai applicants are advised to check with the respective national Contact Points the eligibility as to who may apply and what costs are eligible before a consortium submits the complete application. Furthermore, it is recommended to Thai applicants to read the Thai call text at the following website

Eligibility

Research proposals may be submitted by:

- Research institutions in Thailand
- Universities in Thailand (Public and Private)

Research institutions and University that receive basic funding from the Federal Government and other Thai granting agencies can only be granted funds to cover extra expenditure in addition to their basic financing.

Funding modalities

For researchers funded by NSTDA, the maximum funding allocated per project is 4,000,000 THB for the project with the maximum of three years. NSTDA will support up to 3 projects. The following costs are eligible:

Equipment: fund only when necessary

Consumables: consumable costs are to be spent in Thailand

Personnel costs: please check NSTDA regulation at <http://waa.inter.nstda.or.th/stks/pub/2014/20141030-grant-manual-cpmo.pdf>

Indirect costs: shall not exceed 10%

Additional national eligibility criteria for the proposal beyond the general criteria in the Terms of Reference of the Joint Call is not eligible.

Submission

Beyond the submission of the proposal through the dedicated online tool (PT-OUTLINE) the applicants are asked to send a **signed version of the PT-OUTLINE generated PDF including the institution's stamp** to the Thailand National Focal Point. <https://secure.pt-dlr.de/ptoutline/app/seaeuropejfs>
